

## Findings

Distraction Index (DI): Right DI = 0.51, Left DI = 0.47.  
 Osteoarthritis (OA): **No radiographic evidence of OA for either hip.**  
 Cavitation/Other Findings: No cavitation present.

## Interpretation

Distraction Index (DI): The laxity ranking is based on the hip with the greater laxity (larger DI). In this case the DI used is 0.51.  
 OA Risk Category: The DI is between 0.50 and 0.69. This patient is at moderate risk for hip OA.  
 Distraction Index Chart:



**BREED STATISTICS:** This interpretation is based on a cross-section of 20749 canine patients of the GOLDEN RETRIEVER breed in the AIS PennHIP database. The gray strip represents the central 90% range of DIs (0.33 - 0.80) for the breed. The breed average DI is 0.54 (solid square). The patient DI is the solid circle (0.51).

**SUMMARY:** The degree of laxity (DI = 0.51) falls within the central 90% range of DIs for the breed. This amount of hip laxity places the hip at a moderate risk to develop hip OA. **No radiographic evidence of OA for either hip.**
